The BAS/SEL levels are set as instructional levels for benchmark assessments (BOY, MOY, EOY). Other levels in *italics* represent levels between benchmarks. The EDL will be used to assess Spanish literacy levels in grades 3-5. Tejas LEE is no longer a required assessment for Spanish speakers but may be used per principal preference.

What is the criteria for when to assess and re-assess students?

UNIVERSAL SCREENING - AIMSweb

Grades K-1 Spanish speaking students will be assessed using AIMSweb MIDE (See page 16 in AIMSweb Training Workbook for recommended testing schedule).
 Grades 2-5 Spanish speaking students will be assessed with Spanish probes.
 Grades K-5 English speaking students will be assessed with English probes.

- K-5:** There is no limitation on how far you may test students. The “year above cap” from DRA has been removed due to the increase of rigor in Fountas and Pinnell’s reading assessment systems. RRISD tests students to their highest instructional level. The Benchmark Assessment Instructional Level is the highest level at which a student can read with good opportunities for learning through teaching. **NOTE: Native English Speakers in DL classes will be assessed for instructional level in Spanish using the SEL to level N or the EDL.**
